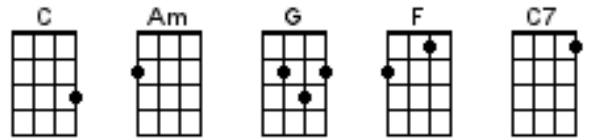


# BEANIE SONG
